

1. awareness	knowing that something exists and is important
2. infection	the act or process of causing or getting a disease
3. lockdown	an official order to control the movement of people or vehicles because of a dangerous situation
4. outbreak	the sudden start of something unpleasant, especially violence or a disease
5. pandemic	a disease that spreads over a whole country or the whole world
6. self-isolation	the practice of voluntarily staying at home and away from other people in case you infect them
7. social distancing	the practice of keeping a safe distance between yourself and other people in order to prevent the spread of disease
8. treatment	the manner in which someone behaves toward or deals with someone or something
9. vaccine	a biological preparation of organisms that provides immunity to a particular infectious disease
10. asymptomatic	presenting no symptoms of a disease
